IDENTITY

The Central Chamber Orchestra, founded in 1983, is composed of 45 musicians devoted to performing good music of all periods from baroque to contemporary. The musicians audition for membership and perform without pay. The orchestra, an independent organization in residence at Central Lutheran Church in Minneapolis, performs throughout the metropolitan area.

PURPOSE

The orchestra exists for two reasons:

- (1) to provide an opportunity for serious musicians to perform fine music;
- (2) to offer the pleasure of high quality concerts to music lovers in the metropolitan area.

CONDUCTOR

Conductor Steven Amundson is Assistant Professor and Director of the Orchestra at St. Olaf College. He also conducts the Bloomington Symphony. Educated at Luther College, Northwestern University and in Austria, he is a nationally popular conductor and teacher at music camps and clinics for young people.

Donations at concerts, rather than ticket sales, provide some support for the orchestra.

However, the chief avenue of support is through The Central Orchestral Association, a non-profit organization created for the sole purpose of supporting the orchestra. A Board of Directors conducts the orchestra's business and promotes its concerts.

The Board invites new members into the Association. Members elect the Board and receive concert schedules and information.
