IDENTITY

The Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra, an independent organization founded in 1982 as the Central Chamber Orchestra, is composed of 60 musicians devoted to performing good music of all periods from baroque to contemporary. The musicians audition for membership and perform without pay throughout the metropolitan area.

PURPOSE

The orchestra exists for two reasons:

1. to provide an opportunity for serious musicians to perform fine music;
2. to offer the pleasure of high quality concerts to music lovers in the metropolitan area.

MUSIC DIRECTOR

Manny Laureano, principal trumpet with the Minnesota Orchestra since 1981, begins his first season as Music Director with the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra this year. A native New Yorker, Manny was educated at Julliard, a finalist in the 1975 International Trumpet Competitions, and held the post of principal trumpet with the Seattle Symphony before assuming his present appointments. His conducting experience includes the Calhoun-Isles Community Band and free-lance conducting in the Twin Cities area as well as Seattle, Washington.
