**IDENTITY AND MISSION** Described as "the very model of a modern major orchestra—community style," by the Minneapolis StarTribune, the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra is on its way to becoming the best civic orchestra in the region. Its mission is to provide an opportunity for serious musicians to perform music of all periods and styles at the highest professional level to diverse audiences throughout the metropolitan area.

**MUSIC DIRECTOR** Manny Laureano has led the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra as its music director since 1987 and has also held the post of principal trumpet with the Minnesota Orchestra since 1981 and co-music director of the Minnesota Youth Symphonies since 1988. A native New Yorker, Mr. Laureano was educated at Julliard, was a finalist in the 1975 International Trumpet Competitions and played principal trumpet with the Seattle Symphony before assuming his present appointments here in Minnesota.

**SUPPORT** Private giving is the major source of support for the orchestra. By covering general operating expenses, these funds enable the orchestra to fulfill its mission through commissioning new works, building a music library and featuring professional musicians as soloists with the orchestra. Contributions from individuals fund over half of the orchestra's monetary needs. Additional support comes from donations at concerts rather than ticket sales, corporate and small business concert sponsorships and the orchestra's annual Benefit concert. Contributors become members of the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestral Association, elect the Board of Directors and have the opportunity to participate in the orchestra's direction and growth.
