Its mission is to provide an opportunity for serious musicians to perform music of all periods and styles at the highest professional level to diverse audiences throughout the metropolitan area.



Music Director Manny Laureano has led The Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra as its music director since 1987. He has also held the post of principal trumpet with the Minnesota Orchestra since 1981 and has been co-music director of the Minnesota Youth Symphonies since 1988. A native New Yorker, Mr. Laureano was educated at Julliard, was a finalist in the 1975 International Trumpet Competitions and

played principal trumpet with the Seattle Symphony before assuming his present appointments here in Minnesota. He is currently on the faculty of the University of Minnesota School of Music.
