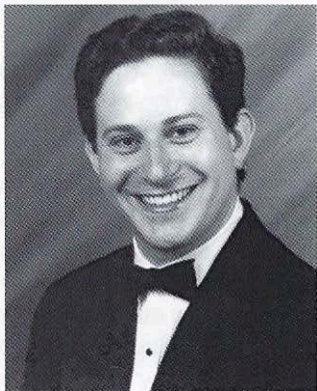

# Introducing William Intriligator



Already well known to Twin Cities audiences, William Intriligator is rapidly emerging as one of today's most promising young conductors. Recently appointed as Music Director of the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra, Mr. Intriligator has also served as Music Director of the St. Paul JCC Symphony Orchestra and the Kenwood Chamber Orchestra. He has served as Apprentice Conductor and Staff/Cover Conductor of the Minnesota Orchestra and as Assistant Conductor of the Minnesota Opera. Mr. Intriligator has conducted the Minnesota Orchestra, a contemporary chamber music concert with the Saint Paul Chamber Orchestra, the Duluth-Superior Symphony, the Bloomington Symphony, the Minnesota Chamber Music Society, the Metropolitan Symphony Orchestra, the University of Minnesota Symphony Orchestra, the Princeton University Orchestra, and the Juilliard Ensemble. A native of

Los Angeles, Mr. Intriligator graduated *summa cum laude* from Princeton University and pursued advanced studies at the University of Minnesota, where he conducted Mozart's *The Magic Flute* in 1993. Mr. Intriligator was a Conducting Fellow at the 1995 Aspen Music Festival. His principle teachers and mentors have been Charles Bruck, Christian Thielemann, Murry Sidlin, Eije Oue, and Michael Gielen, to whom he acted as Apprentice Conductor of the Sudwestfunk Symphony Orchestra in Baden-Baden, Germany, from 1992-1993.
